SAINT CHARLES PARK & RECREATION BOARD MINUTES PARK BOARD MEETING HELD June 21st, 2017

The meeting was <u>Called to Order</u> by President Bichel at 6:03pm in the Meeting Room in Memorial Hall. <u>Roll Call</u> noted the following present for the meeting:

Items for Discussion and/or Action:

A. Prop P Projects Update

Britton presented the Board with actual and estimated pricing for all of the Prop P projects. Some transfers may be brought back before the Board so that the correct amount of funding would be in place for the specific playground projects.

A discussion also took place in regards to the Wapelhorst Entrance Road. Potentially \$300,000 may be needed outside of the City/County Road funding for the "interior park road" portion of the project.

Fichtenmayer made a motion to make a request to the City Administration/City Council to borrow the \$300,000 from the City and then repay it with excess Prop P funds when they come in; seconded by Lanning which passed.

B. Transfers over \$10,000*

Britton presented the information on the transfers. These transfers were needed to make sure sufficient funding is in each of the athletic filed lighting projects. Lanning made a motion to recommend the transfers; seconded by Nowak which passed.

C. Authorizing a Contract with Contegra Construction Company, LLC for the Wapelhorst and Blanchette Family Aquatic Centers Project in the Amount of \$15,495,778 and Authorizing a Change Order Contingency in the Amount of \$775,000 for a Total Not to Exceed Amount of \$16,270,778

Britton presented the information. The bids were opened June 6th, 2017. Staff/consultant recommended accepting the base bid along with the 3 alternates.

Nowak made a motion to approve the Contract; seconded by Lanning which passed.

D. Inclusion Coordinator Contract for Fiscal year July 1, 2017 to June 31, 2018 in an amount not to exceed \$10,054.57.*

Britton presented the information. Garvey made a motion to approve the Contract; seconded by Lanning which passed.

E. Purchase order with Hackmann Lumber for the purchase of building materials needed for the building of the new McNair Maintenance Facility in an amount not to exceed \$26,000*

Atkinson presented the information. Fichtenmayer made a motion to approve the purchase; seconded by Nowak which passed.

Lanning made a motion approve Item A. of the consent agenda; seconded by Garvey which passed.
