They will each have new replacement plans once completed in 2018. From the Metro Sales Tax funds in 2019 funds have been added to complete Boschert Greenway Phase 3, and to add a new playground to Circle Drive Park. In out years funds have been added to rehab Trails and Parking Lots.

From the Prop P Sales Tax funding has been added in 2019 and 2020 for a Skate park/Bicycle Park, replacement of the playground and pavilion at Kiwanis Park, playground replacements at the Sports Complex, Schaefer, McNair and Fox Hill Park and adding new restrooms at Webster and Frontier Park.

4. Consideration for Recommendation 2019 – 2024 Cemetery Capital Improvement Plan*
