## 3. 2019 Maintenance Report

VanLinn presented the information. Highlighted the parks, acreage, buildings, amenities, equipment/vehicles and features that maintenance staff maintain on a daily basis. Highlighted the challenges experienced by staff in 2019. Primarily dealing with the Missouri/Mississippi Flooding that impacted several parks. Highlighted some projects completed in 2019. Pedestrian bridge updates, monument sign replacement, LED lighting upgrades and construction of Wapelhorst Tennis Court Restrooms to name a few. The Board thanked VanLinn and his staff for all they do for the Department.

## 4. Update on Centennial Greenway Phase 3

Britton updated the Board that some public meetings had taken place about possible trail alignments for the new trail. Some of the residents expressed some dissatisfaction with the trail route next to the Wilshire Valley subdivision. Parks & City staff have since met with GRG and the consultant to suggest an alternative route to gain access to the park that does not impact the Wilshire Valley Subdivision common ground. Further design meetings and public meetings will take place as the design progresses.
