## 3. Aquatics Update and Year End Closing Schedule

Borgmeyer presented the information on attendance and revenue/expenses for 2020 and in comparison with year to date in 2019. The McNair facility will close to the public on Sunday August 9th, the Blanchette facility on Sunday August 16th (Then going to lap swim only). The Wapelhorst facility will close for the year on Monday September 7th. There are possible changes to the Wapelhorst public swim hours in August due to staffing concerns.

Staff are also working with Lindenwood University and some local school districts on allowing them to use the lap pool at Blanchette for their swim teams.

#### 4. Recreation Programs Update

Borgmeyer updated the Board that there was 1 week left of Summer Fun Day Camp and then they will be done for the year. Enrollments for both indoor programming and outdoor programming have been going well. The summer softball season is wrapping up and enrollment has been good for the fall season.

### 5. Motorcycle Range Update

This building would be used to store 3 wheeled motorcycles that used to be stored in a temporary shipping container. That container has recently been removed. This new building would match the existing 3 buildings and would be placed in the same location as those buildings. Coordination with the City, Boeing and with a local consultant would be needed.
