3. Discussion of the 200 Acre Parks/School Project and Master Plan

The consultants from SWT Design updated the Park Board about the progress on the 200 acre Park/Orchard Farm School District Master Planning Project. They highlighted a tentative schedule, examples of past master plans they have worked on with other City's/School Districts, the topographic lay of the land and the utility easements that are on site. The consensus coming out of the several meetings that have been held between the school district staff, parks department staff and the 2 consultant teams is that property needs to be re-divided from its current configuration to something that will allow both entities to have more squared off property lines rather than long linear tracts of land. SWT also shared with the Board the results of the first public input meeting that was held on 12/17/20. In addition to 15 people attending the meeting in person we received 462 responses to the online survey. Those responses showed the areas and amenities that the public would like to see placed on the 100 acre park portion of this property. Those suggestions and staff comments would then be used to begin laying out possible park site plans for discussion at future public and Park Board meetings.
