3. McNair Aquatic Facility Discussion

In light of the continued deterioration of the McNair facility, Staff provided a tour to view and discuss the ongoing issues and newer issues arising that are making the operation of the facility difficult for staff.

Currently the biggest and most expensive issues facing the facility are:

New pumps and motors: \$75,000 - \$100,000

New Filter tanks: \$70,000 - \$100,000

New Slide and tower replacement: \$200,000+ Sand blasting and repainting the pool shell: \$50,000

Water leak: Unknown location, cost and necessary repairs.

The main pool building and the pump house also have issues, some cosmetic, that will be expensive to repair/replace.


Concern that if major repairs begin to occur, the entire facility will need to be brought into compliance with the latest Model Aquatics Health Code.

McNair Aquatic Facility averages 121 guests per day or 7% of our total guests per day at all 3 facilities, operates at a loss of +/- \$50,000 per year and requires staff that could be utilized at other facilities as it becomes more difficult to recruit lifeguards.
