

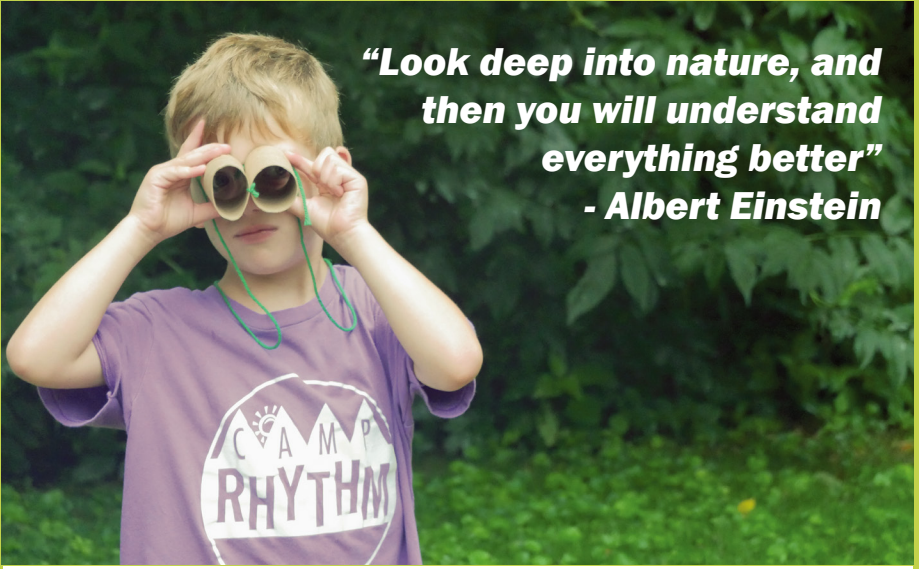

PUNDMANN NATURE PARK

The newest addition to our parks system is coming to St. Charles thanks to the generous land donation from the Pundmann family.

Unlike traditional parks with metal playground structures, asphalt, and manicured landscaping, Pundmann Nature Park will embrace the wild beauty of the natural world. The park will feature nature-inspired playscapes, created from fallen trees, rocks, and native plant life.

Pundmann Nature Park isn't just another park—it's an experience that blends education, adventure, and the beauty of the outdoors. Located in a peaceful, largely residential area, the park offers a refreshing break from the hustle and bustle of daily life, providing visitors with a tranquil setting to explore and learn.

“This is going to be more natural than our other parks,” said Maralee Britton, the Director of St. Charles Parks and Recreation. “It is going to be kept in a more natural habitat to create a space for nature in the middle of the City of St. Charles.”

Unique Features You May Find at Pundmann Nature Park


- Natural Playscapes including stepping boulders, tree stump steppers, rock balance beam, log tunnel, and more!
- Interactive learning kiosks like a magnifying station, ant/worm farm, weather station, and sensory box.
- A pavilion for an immersive outdoor education classroom.
- Informational signs about various native flowers and plants growing in the park.
- Opportunities for park staff, master gardener volunteers, and others to host schools and other groups for exciting learning opportunities.

A PARK WITH A PURPOSE

At the bottom of this page is a potential layout of Pundmann Nature Park. Discover where you might find some of the amenities you will read about in this brochure.

 The Nature Play area is where you will find amenities that will create an immersive, natural environment. In this area you may find stepping boulders, a rock balance beam, and the log tunnel.

 The Nature Learn area combines native landscapes with amenities that are fun while being informative. You may find listening tubes, an ant/worm farm, and the magnifying glass here.

 The Sensory area will help children explore how their actions affect their surroundings while promoting curiosity and creativity. Amenities you might find here include the gadget board, the sensory box, and the weather station

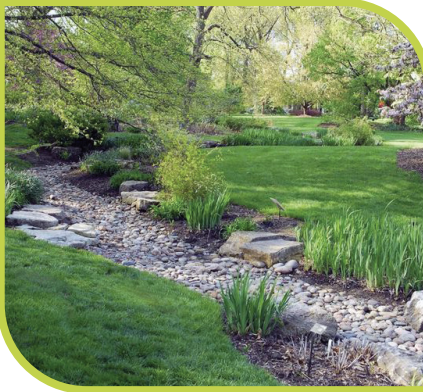
